**Ted Gianoutsos' Proposed Two-Trillion-Dollar**

**NEW-ANWR Legislation**

**ALASKA NATURAL RESOURCES ACT (ANRA)**

**Key Provisions:**

- 1. Immediately open the 1002 area of the coastal plain of ANWR to responsible oil and gas development.**
  
- 2. Split the governmental revenue from ANWR oil and gas production 3 ways;**
  - 1/3<sup>rd</sup> - State of Alaska,**
  - 1/3<sup>rd</sup> - Federal Government,**
  - 1/3<sup>rd</sup> - National Endowment for Wildlife (NEW).**
  
- 3. The creation of the National Endowment for Wildlife (NEW), headquartered in Alaska, with 1/3<sup>rd</sup> of ANWR's revenues to be invested solely in U.S. Treasury securities with annual interest distributed to all 50 states for wildlife and wilderness conservation in proportion to each states' wildlife and wilderness.**
